

Standards on V the Regional essay contest "Learning languages - I learn the globalized world" (Russian, English, French, German, Spanish, Chinese) among students of educational institutions and institutions of correctional and distance learning within the framework of the "Accessible Environment" project



1. Introduction

1.1. Founders of the Regional essay contest "Learning languages - I get to know the globalized world" (hereinafter - the Contest):

1.2. Goals and objectives of the Contest:

- to provide an opportunity for students with special and limited needs to present the results of their activities to a wide audience;
- to identify and support students interested in in-depth study of foreign languages, to increase the motivation of schoolchildren in teaching a foreign language in order to maintain and develop interest in the subject under study;
- to contribute to the development of the creative potential of students and the formation of an individual educational trajectory of the student through his involvement in project activities in the classroom and in the extracurricular environment;
- to teach the ways and techniques of academic writing, contributing to the formation of an intellectually developed personality with a holistic view of the picture of the world;
- to strengthen cooperation between Russian secondary general education and higher professional institutions in the framework of project work.

1.3. Subject of work:

- Language is my guide.
- My city is the center of peace and patriotism.
- Science 2020-2030
- Technologies 2020-2030

2. General Provisions

2.1. These Regulations determine the procedure for organizing and conducting the essay contest.

2.2. The participants of the Contest are:

- students of 5-7, 8-9 and 10-11 grades of general educational institutions of the Volgograd region;
- students of 5-7, 8-9 and 10-11 grades of correctional and distance learning institutions,

students.

2.3. According to the results of the 2nd round of the contest, the first, second and third places are established for each of the declared foreign languages. The Organizing Committee of the contest and the Contest Commission may make a special decision regarding the promotion of participants with appropriate justification.

3. Dates of the contest

3.1. The contest is held from October 1 to November 30, 2021 on the basis of Volgograd State University in 2 rounds: admission of works according to the general requirements (laureates) and selection of the best works (winners and prize-winners). The best works selected in the 2nd round can be invited to a solemn awarding ceremony at VolSU (November 2021).

3.2. Authors and supervisors of works recognized as the best on the 2nd round are notified by e-mail and are invited to an online session with the organizing committee with a presentation of the best works. The exact date, time and platform will be announced additionally on the website <https://www.picconf.ru.net/contests-olympiads>. Participation in the award ceremony or any other way of receiving award materials is discussed with the organizing committee by e-mail contest@picconf.ru.net.

3.3. Competitive works are submitted to the Organizing Committee from October 1 to November 10, 2021 in electronic form to the address of the Organizing Committee contest@picconf.ru.net with an attached file. Indicate in the subject line: ESSAY CONTEST -2021. Or to the department 4-99B for Bass E.V.

3.4. The results of the contest are announced no later than 5 days before the awarding ceremony at VolSU.

4. Conditions of the Contest

4.1. Works of students of general educational institutions of any type are accepted for the contest.

4.2. The contest is held for students in grades 5-7, 8-9 and 10-11, as well as students of educational institutions.

4.3. All materials must be submitted in electronic form to the address of the organizing committee contest@picconf.ru.net.

4.3.1. The total volume of work is no more than 2 pages. Times New Roman font, size 14; line spacing one and a half; justified alignment; first line indent - 1.25 cm; margins: right - 1 cm, left - 3 cm, top and bottom - 2 cm. Information must be present.

4.3.2. Information is indicated in the upper left corner, left justified, italicized and contains:

- full name of the educational institution (place of study);
- title of work;
- name and surname of the participant of the contest;
- class;
- e-mail address of the competitor;
- surname, name, patronymic of the teacher (s) indicating the position;
- teacher's email address;
- place of work of the teacher (if different from the competitor).

4.4. The contest commission is approved by the Organizing Committee of the contest.

4.5. The contest commission in its activities is guided by these Regulations.

4.6. The right to evaluate the works submitted to the contest and to make a decision on identifying the winners is vested in the Contest Commission consisting of:

4.7. The selection of the winners of the Contest is carried out by the Contest commission by a simple majority of votes based on the results of the 2nd stage.

4.8. Participation in the Contest is free.

4.9. Works submitted to the Contest will not be returned.

4.10. The works are evaluated according to the following criteria:

- the authenticity of the content of the essay (the authenticity / originality of the text must be more than 60%, do not contain plagiarism from sources of creative works);
- the presence of argumentation, the development of the topic, the author's own position;
- full disclosure of the topic;
- literacy of presentation (absence of punctuation, grammatical, lexical, stylistic errors);
- the ability to use adequate language means and complex grammatical structures (in the respective languages).

5. Summing up the results of the Competition

5.1. All authors-laureates of competition works are awarded with electronic certificates of participants of the Contest with an individual form number.

5.2. The winner and prize-winners will be awarded with diplomas with an individual form number.
